EU-Armenia: Shaping a positive agenda for future co-operation

Commissioner Johannes **Hahn** will visit Yerevan on 18 March to underline the current important and decisive year for [EU-Armenia relations](#), marked by the joint commitment and effort to enhance EU-Armenia relations, where possible and to negotiate a legal base for these future relations. During his mission, he is scheduled to meet the Armenian President, Prime-Minister and Minister for Foreign Affairs, as well as representatives of the opposition and civil society. In addition, accompanied by the Armenian Minister of Education, he will visit the Yerevan Regional State College No 1, a Vocational Education Training Project supported by the European Commission.
